Horses and ponies are 5 to 15 times larger, 20 to 40 times more powerful, and 3 to 4 times faster than a human. If a rider falls from a horse to the gound it will generally be at a distance of from 4 to 5 ½ feet, and the impact may result in injury to the rider. Horseback riding is the only sport where one much smaller, weaker, predator animal (human) tries to impose its will on, and become one unit of movement with another much larger, stronger prey animal with a mind of its own (horse) and each has a limited understanding of the other. When a horse is frightened or provoked it may divert from its training and act according to its instincts which may include, but is not limited to: stopping short, changing directions or speed at will; shifting its weight; bucking, rearing, kicking, biting, or running. Please also read Wisconsin Equine Statue in BOLD below incorporated herein by reference.

Parent's Consent and Release: The undersigned parent(s) of the above named customer, a minor, hereby consents that said minor may participate in the farm activities including but not limited to the teaching and training program(s) and equine activities, collectively referred to herein as "Farm Activities" of Erin Meadows Farm LLC and Donald and Mary Jane Gallo and hereby release Erin Meadows Farm and Donald and Mary

Jane Gallo from all liability for any injury that might occur to said minor during the course thereof.
